The market also supports SNAP options, organizes food drives, and hosts family activities and educational opportunities. The regular Market season opens Saturday, May 3, 2025, at the Suffolk Visitor Center Pavilion. Located at 524 North Main Street, the Market operates 9 a.m. until 1 p.m., Saturdays through November 22, 2025.
